



Development on Spuzzum Lands will support community members to gather and to lead an active and healthy lifestyle by creating a network of pathways and by celebrating the natural beauty of the area and the Fraser River. Economic development opportunities along Highway 1 will provide employment opportunities for members and commercial goods and services to members and non-members. However, as the highway and the rail line travel through the community, public safety is a top priority and will be considered as part of all new developments. The overall vision is to promote development that supports current members and our future generation to live, learn, work, and gather on Spuzzum Lands.
