Did you know...

- NITEP was established in 1974
- It is a 5 year Bachelor of Education degree program for Aboriginal students that may be completed in 4 years
- There are 2 options; Elementary or Secondary
- The first 2 to 3 years of study are completed at a NITEP field centre so students can remain close to their home community, family and support systems
- At the Fraser Valley Centre, students register with UBC for their Education courses and Seabird College for their Arts and Science electives, which are offered through UFV, NVIT and/or TRU
- Students may transfer up to 60 credits into the program
- Block transfer is available for individuals with an ECE certificate or diploma
- Small class size allows for individual support from the NITEP Coordinator
- Program graduates work in all areas of education; locally, provincially, nationally and globally
- NITEP is widely recognized for its high standards and outstanding graduates
