Develop and refine internal policies while consulting and communicating with all members on and off-Reserve.



Develop and implement a communications strategy and engagement policy to lay out our best practices for communicating and gathering input from members.



Develop strategies with neighbouring communities to deal with concerns about the lack of public transportation.



Develop and implement the Spuzzum Land Use Plan. (development underway now)



Develop maps with information on culturally sensitive and important areas in our Traditional Territory.



Develop a Social Development Policy to promote personal independence and less reliance on Social Assistance.



Develop pre-K-12 policies and programs to promote high school graduation.



Develop post-secondary funding policies to support any member who would like to further their education.



Promote the First Nation Healthy Food Guidelines to enhance our overall nutrition and health.
